Introduction

An integrated information system, the Fresno State PeopleSoft Student Administration System is a pilot implementation of the Common Management Systems ([CMS](#)) project, a CSU system-wide enterprise that has the goal to implement the PeopleSoft HR/Student Administration modules in all 23 campuses. The system will support modules for admissions, financial aid, student records, academic advising, student financials and campus community. It features integrated Electronic Data Interchange (EDI), Internet, self-service functionality, electronic course catalog and scheduling.

Project Vision

It is the vision of the Student Transaction and Administrative Records System (STARS) to provide anytime, anywhere access to information and administrative services to the Fresno State campus community.

Project Mission

The primary mission of the project, is to implement an interactive and Internet-based delivery of administrative and information services to all university constituents with the following functionality:

1. An underlying software infrastructure that will support robust web-based delivery of administrative services and information to all university constituents and that will readily adapt to new innovations in technology.
2. An integrated suite of administrative applications in which data is entered only once and is consistent and accurate across all applications and business units.
3. Easy to use and understand access to administrative and information services.
4. A streamlined set of self-service tools for the delivery of administrative and information services.
5. A system designed to grow and adapt with the University's need for Information technology.
